Dear Mr. Scott,

Reverting to the last paragraph on sheet 3 of my letter of the 26th ultimo with reference to the visit of the Vice-Director of the Leningrad Shipbuilding Trust to Moscow, I saw this gentleman this afternoon and he informed me that the question of class and supervision of certain proposed vessels was not yet definitely settled and he would let me know further regarding the matter after they had received a definite reply from the Register of U.S.S.R.; he will be visiting Moscow again within the next week or so and will let me know the result of his further conversations with the Register regarding the classification and supervision of future vessels.

It will be noted that in my conversation with the Head Superintendent of the Baltic Head Office of the Sovtorg Flot at this port, with reference to the withdrawal of class of the s.s. "KOVDA" as mentioned in my letter of the 1st instant, their Office had not received any information regarding the withdrawal of class of any of their other ships.

I will write you again as soon as I receive any further information regarding this matter.
