

The Annual Survey of the Oil Engines became due in May, 1920.

On several occasions the Owner informed the Seville Surveyor that on the vessel's arrival at that port the necessary inspection would take place. On the 8th February the Surveyor wrote that in his opinion the Owner was only trying to gain time, and on the 18th February the Classing Committee deferred action in the matter for six weeks.

The case again came up for consideration on Tuesday, the 12th instant, upon a further communication received from the Surveyor at Seville, from which it appeared that the Owner had informed him that he expected the vessel to call at that port and that he had instructed the Captain to hold the survey at the first opportunity, but when and where he could not say. In the circumstances the Classing Committee decided to expunge the vessel's class with a red line (4-21), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
