This case received the consideration of the Committee on the 31st August and 23rd November last when they deferred action in the matter as the Owner stated he proposed to have the above survey carried out on the vessel's arrival at Seville.

On the 8th February the Seville Surveyor forwarded a letter he had received from the Owner reading as follows:-

"I have waited a long while before replying to your favour of the 12th January in the hope that i might be able to say that the aux.vessel "SANTA ANA" would arrive at Seville and the survey could be held there. As soon as the vessel does arrive at Seville, however, the survey will be carried out and in any case I have sent to the Captain the list of ports where you have Surveyors so that the survey may be carried out at the first one where the vessel will call"

The Surveyor added that he did not think the Owner meant what he said but that he was only trying to gain time and awaiting an opportunity to send the vessel to Seville.

The case received the further consideration of the Committee on the 18th February when they deferred action in the matter for six weeks.


