In August last the Seville Surveyor stated he had been informed by the Owner that as soon as the vessel arrived at his port the above survey would be carried out. In the circumstances the Committee deferred action in the matter for a short time.

In reply to enquiry as to within what definite time the Owner proposed to hold the above survey, the Seville Surveyor wrote on the 15th November:-

"I have called once more on the Owner Mr. Rios Sarmiento who repeated what he said before that he expects the ship to come loaded to Seville and here he will do all necessary"

Action was again deferred by the Committee for a short time.

The Seville Surveyor now forwards a letter received from the Owner reading as follows:-

"while before replying to your favour of the 12th January  
"in the hope that I might be able to say that the aux. vessel  
"SANTA ANA" would arrive at Seville and the survey could  
"be held there. As soon as the vessel does arrive at Seville,  
"however, the survey will be carried out and in any case  
"I have sent to the Captain the list of ports where you  
"have Surveyors so that the survey may be carried out at the  
"first one where the vessel will call".

The Surveyor adds that he does not think the  
Owner means what he says but that he is only trying to gain  
time and awaiting an opportunity to send the vessel to Seville.
