With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steamer "HORACE S. WILKINSON", I beg to remind you that the Committee have hitherto allowed the vessel's class to remain subject to the Special Survey No.1, which became due in May 1923 being carried out before she was again placed in commission.

They have now had before them, however, a letter received from the Society's Surveyor at Cleveland, from which it appears that the vessel has been placed in employment without the Special Survey requirements being carried out, and that your Representative has stated that it is not your intention to continue the classification with this Society.

In the circumstances, the Committee regret that they are unable to allow the vessel to retain her class in the Register Book, and have accordingly given instructions for the character to be expunged with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
