On the 24th August last the Committee agreed to a proposal of the Owners to have the above surveys held at the close of the season's navigation.

On the 5th February the New York Surveyors wrote they were advised by the Society's Surveyor at Cleveland that he had not been able to make further arrangements for carrying out the above surveys, the Owners having requested that the matter of the continuance of the classification ^{might} be deferred until the opening of navigation, the vessel being laid up for the winter. In the circumstances the Committee deferred action for a time.
