No. 3 SURVEY PARTLY HELD.

When due 9.19 When proposed to be completed

Portion of Survey held, &c.,

The Acting Surveyor at Lisbon in September last reported that the S.S.No.3, due 9.19, had been held with the exception of the examination in dry dock. *the drawing of the sunshaft*

As, however, it appeared that the fishroom had been extended to the collision bulkhead and some alterations effected in the fore peak, the Surveyor was informed that additional strengthening would be required in the fore peak if the same was intended to be used as a tank.

The Surveyor on the 18th. December last stated that the Owner was not prepared to do anything more to the vessel until she dry docked in February or March of this year for cleaning purposes, and he recommended that these matters stand over until that time.

The same Surveyor on the 13th. ultimo stated he had been able to obtain information that this vessel was expected back in Lisbon about the 18th. or 20th. April, and that so far arrangements had been made to dry dock her a few days afterwards.

A further letter has now been received from the ^{Acting} Surveyor at Lisbon stating the vessel has been sold to act as a steam pilot boat and he is waiting information in regard to the final settlement of

the same. He adds that the present Owner states that as the vessel is practically sold he will not be doing any more to her and that as soon as she is passed into new hands he will endeavour to have the completion of the No. 3 survey carried out and will advise this Office as soon as he has definite information.

It is submitted action might be deferred to allow time for a further letter to be received from the Surveyor.
