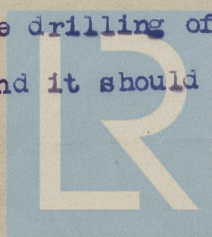

Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter dated 20th October with regard to the steam trawler "CINTRA" I have to acknowledge receipt of tracing showing the original profile of the vessel and it appears that confusion has been caused by my considering the weather deck as upper deck including stepdown in forecastle accommodation and I intended to infer by main deck level the position that main deck would occupy if it were constructed in the vessel in question. Actually the tank which has been constructed has its top at the same level as the beams under the original boatswains store. Referring to my rough sketch sent, it appears that a small tank had been constructed up to a point indicated on the sketch but I found that the tank was being extended when I went on board to hold the survey on the vessel. Owners advise me that this vessel is at present away fishing and if possible on her return will arrange so that I can see same again to get the particulars you require, but they state that they have no wish for this tank to be classified as a ballast tank as it is only used for fresh water when vessel makes long fishing trips and under the circumstances beg to request your instructions as to whether any further work is necessary and submit that in my opinion the tank is efficient for the purpose intended and has not altered the construction of the vessel as it existed originally.

With regard to the drilling of shell plating this was not considered necessary and it should have/stated that the
