Nature of Survey

First entry

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Middlesbrough Surveyors should be informed that this vessel has proceeded to their port to be fitted with her engines and boilers, and to complete the survey for classification the following remains to be done:—
WT doors, hand pumps and Downton pump to be tried, pillars to strong beams in E&B space, casing and tunnel top to be riveted. The Captain's name, date of appointment &c., requires to be obtained.

The Surveyors should be requested to give the case the necessary attention and on completion of the above work to their satisfaction they should report upon the same on form No.8 for the information of the Committee with a view to the vessel's classification.
