S. With reference to your letter of the 28th June last addressed to the Society's Surveyor at Bombay, relative to the classification of your Steamers "REPTON", "BRADFIELD", "SALFORD", and "APPELDORP", I am directed to acquaint you that in the case of the "REPTON" and "BRADFIELD" the Committee have decided to withdraw the vessels' classes and to insert three dots (...), indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

In regard to the "SALFORD" and "APPELDORP", the Committee note that it is not your intention to proceed with the survey for classification, and the notation in the Register Book of "A.L. Coasting Bombay and Goa (Class Contemplated)" will be omitted accordingly in each instance.
