Some time ago Messrs. E. Bacon & Company, who are the Managers for the Owners of the above mentioned trawlers - The Lindsey Steam Fishing Company, the White Sea & Grimsby Trawlers, Limited and the Arctic Steam Fishing Company, Limited -, stated that it was intended to discontinue the classification of these vessels in the Society's Register Book.

The matter has been taken up with the Managers by the Senior Surveyor at Grimsby, but they state that they are unable to modify their previous decision in the matter.

The above mentioned vessels are now ~~over~~ due for survey, and in the circumstances the Classing Committee, who had the cases before them on Friday, 4th instant, decided to give instructions for the class of each trawler to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
