Columns include: Stringers, Inner Bottom Plating, State if Tanks have been examined inside, State if Tanks now tested, Bulkheads, Ceiling, Cement or Asphalt, Rudder, Steering gear and its connections, Windlass, Have Pumps now been examined and found efficient?, Have Sluice Valves now been examined and found efficient?, Have Watertight Doors now been examined and found efficient?, Dblng.
