I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 11th instant relative to the steam trawler "DORCAS", and note that this vessel is at present fishing out of Lowestoft and that you desire to take advantage of the year of grace in which to carry out the 3rd Special Survey No.1.

The case has received careful consideration and I am directed to acquaint you that while the Committee will not object to the Special Survey being postponed they have asked me to draw your attention to the fact that the vessel has not been seen in dry dock by the Society's Surveyors since March, 1934. It is concluded, therefore, that she will be drydocking in the near future, and the Committee would be glad if you would at that time kindly arrange for an opportunity to be given the Society's Surveyors to make a general examination of the trawler, which, being satisfactory, would enable the Committee to grant the full year of grace as desired.
