I beg to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a letter from the Controller, Small Craft Department, Disposal & Liquidation Commission, in which he states that the ferro-concrete vessels "CRETACITE", "CRETICORAL", "CRETICORN" and "CRETILL" have been purchased by your good selves and with regard thereto I have to say that the Committee have agreed to the classes of these vessels being retained in the Register Book only on the understanding that the Annual Surveys which became due at the end of November, 1920 will be carried out before the vessels are again employed.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will kindly let me know, for the information of the Committee, what steps you propose taking to have the requisite inspections held.
