Ferro-Concrete Coaling Vessels.

With reference to your letter of the 18th, I have to confirm that Concrete Coaling vessels "CRETACITE", "CRETECOAL", "CRETECOKE" & "CRETELL" have never been on service for this Department, and are in care of the Admiralty until sold; also, that this Department does not intend to have them surveyed prior to sale.

Prospective purchasers, however, will be informed that the annual surveys must be carried out before these vessels are again sent to sea, and that the vessels retain their Class seantime subject to this being done.

It is considered that this letter should cover the conditions mentioned in your letter under review; other vessels sold by this Department having been disposed of under similar conditions.
