Dear Sirs,

I am asked by the Committee to refer to the case of the steamer "SEMIRAMIS" ex "KYLEGORM" in which we have received a letter from your Piraeus Office to the effect that the vessel, now under Panamanian Flag, has been entered in the Greek Veritas.

You will doubtless remember that at the time of her sale, special application was made by the new Owners to be given an interim and loadline certificate for the voyage from the Bristol Channel to Greece where it was stated a full Special Survey and all the extensive repairs necessary would be carried out for class maintenance.

In good faith the Committee granted this concession, but it now appears that other arrangements have been made and that the Society's recommendations for repairs will not be carried out under the supervision of Lloyd's Register as was anticipated.

Accordingly, they have given instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Black Line indicating that, from reported defects, she is no longer eligible for a character therein. The Society's Surveyors at Piraeus have been instructed to inform your Piraeus Office accordingly.
