
Dear Sir,

With reference to your classing letter of the 14th instant respecting the case of the m.s."GENOTA", Hamburg First Entry Report № 21508, I have to advise you that on going into the matter of the weights of the heads of the first and third bower anchors supplied on board of this vessel it is found that the weights of the heads of these two anchors have been interchanged and that it would have been correct if for the first bower a weight of head of 47.1.0 ctws. (№ 9607) and for the third bower a weight of head of 38.2.14 cwt. (№ 241) were given in the report. The error made is regretted.

The rotor type bilge pumps driven by the main engines are of the self priming type.
