
has been surveyed at Hamburg


in October 1952 and in May 1953

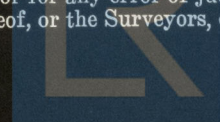
