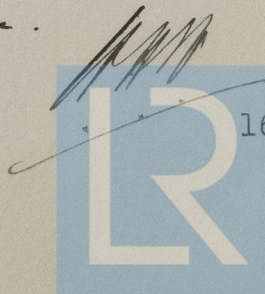
The London Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, the bottom cleaned and coated and minor repairs effected.

The rudder stock was found slightly twisted, but it was not considered necessary to deal with the same at this time.

The Surveyors, however, recommend that the rudder be lifted and specially examined at the next dry docking.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 5,23, subject as recommended.
