the Owners' Representative attend on board the Steel Screw Steamer "GRANJA", of Lisbon, 765 tons gross register, on the 28th April, 1923, and subsequent dates, when the vessel was lying in the Regent Dry Dock, Millwall, London, for the purpose of examining parts of the machinery.

The following repairs were recommended by the undersigned, and were effected to his satisfaction:-
The screw shaft was found flawed in a number of places, and the spare shaft was fitted in its place with a new key.
The stern bush was found cracked, and was renewed; the forward bush and the stern gland were re-metalled.
The oil gland was overhauled and re-metalled, and new springs fitted.
The lubricating pipes to stern tubes were taken ashore and cleaned, and the oil pump removed from the Engine Room to the after peak.
The sea-cocks and valves were overhauled.
