*Extract from letter dated* 5th Sept.1919 *received from* \_\_\_\_\_The Society's Surveyor at Lisbon*Original letter with* "Gaza"*Vessel's Name* "GRANJA"

I am in receipt of your communication dated 19th August with regard to the S.S. "GAZA" and S.S. "GRANJA" and I have to state that the "GRANJA" is at present in dry dock and is being thoroughly overhauled and the "GAZA" is also alongside quay and is expecting to enter dry dock this weekend. Engines are being very thoroughly overhauled with boilers and all machinery and whilst in dock the propeller shaft will be withdrawn and all parts will be thoroughly examined. With regard to the hull, this is being chipped and painted, holds cleaned ~~inside~~ out etc., but it is not intended to repair the damage to the decks of this vessel caused by fire on this occasion owing to the lack of material and facilities at the present time.
