Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that this Society have had under their consideration a letter received from their Surveyor at Lisbon, in which he states that the steamer "GRANJA" is trading to Lourenco Marques, and that it is the Owners' intention to have the Special Survey No. 1 (which according to this Society's Rules became due at the end of November 1916) carried out there with the exception of dry docking, which will be done at Cape Town.

In the circumstances the Committee will be obliged if you will kindly appoint a competent and independent Surveyor to carry out the Survey held at Lourenco Marques, and I enclose for his information sample Reports together with an Abstract from the Society's Rules, setting forth the requirements of the Survey in question.

Forms for reporting the Survey are also enclosed, which should be returned to this Office in due course, and I may say that all fees and expenses in connexion with the matter must be paid by the Owners or their representatives, and should accordingly be charged by you to them.
