I have to acquaint you I am informed by the Society's Surveyor at Lisbon that the steamer "GRANJA" is trading to Lorenzo Marques and that it is the Owners' intention to have the Special Survey No. 1. carried out there with the exception of the dry docking which will be done at Cape Town. In the circumstances, the Committee have agreed to Lloyd's Agents at Lorenzo Marques appointing a competent and independent Surveyor to carry out the survey held there and the necessary instructions in regard to the matter are being sent to them.

I have to add that Lloyd's Agents are also being informed that the vessel is to be dry docked at Cape Town and they are being requested to keep you advised as to how the case stands.
