This vessel originally belonged to German Owners, and was seized by the Portuguese Government, and as it appeared she had arrived at Lisbon recently, the Surveyor at that port was communicated with.

In reply he wrote:-

"I have to state that no action was taken during the vessel's stay at this port at that time and vessels were only being classed for Messrs. Furness Withy & Co., the Comissao de Transportes Maritimos not deeming surveying and classing of vessels necessary. Now they have agreed to submit the vessel for survey, etc., when next she dry docks at this port, which they trust will meet with the Committee's approval."

In the circumstances the Committee deferred the consideration of the case for a time.

A further letter has now come to hand from the Lisbon Surveyor on the subject reading as follows:-

"Further to mine of 30th January and in reply to yours of 12th instant re the above named vessel, Messrs. Transportes Maritimos do Estado now ask you to send the necessary instructions to Lorenzo Marques for the Special Survey No. 1 to be held or commenced as this vessel is now trading out there and will not return to Lisbon for some time and she could be docked at Cape Town, etc. where their vessels generally go for cleaning purposes.

"They also add that at the present moment vessel is at Mocambique and when the survey is completed if you will kindly have the Certificates, etc. sent to this Office."
