With reference to my letter of the 25th of July and your reply of the 2nd of August last, I shall be glad to learn how the cases of the steamers "SACAVEM" and "LAGOS" now stand. You will also be so good as to forward to this office the report of your survey of the steamer "GRANJA", and at the same time let me know when it is expected the screw shaft of this vessel will be submitted to inspection.

At the same time I think it well to enclose herewith, for your information, a list giving particulars of the surveys outstanding on certain vessels recently seized by the Portuguese Government, and shall be glad if you will ascertain and let me know what steps are proposed to be taken to have these inspections held in order to entitle the vessels to retain their classes in the Register Book.
