Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the Steamer "VAQUILLONA", which vessel it is understood has recently become your property, I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Buenos Aires, from which it appears that it is not your intention to continue the vessel's class in the Society's Register Book.

As the Second Special Survey No.1 became due so long ago as January, 1919 the Committee regret that they have had no option but to expunge the vessel's class from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have to add that upon the receipt of a satisfactory report from the Society's Surveyors on the completion of the necessary survey and repairs, the case will receive the favourable consideration of the Committee, with a view to the re-instatement of the class.
