The Special Survey No.1 which became due in February, 1916 was not carried out owing to the vessel being on Government Service.

The Special Survey No.2 which became due in February, 1920 has been held with the exception of the examination of the bunkers.

The Boiler Survey became due in October, 1920.

In August, 1920 the Owners stated that they proposed to convert her into a cargo vessel, and the Committee agreed in the special circumstances to allow the completion of the Special Survey No.2 to be postponed until May, 1921.

Letters have been addressed to the Owners on the 6th June and 23rd August to which no reply has been received.

On the 9th instant they were informed that unless a reply were received, there would be no alternative but to expunge the class without further notice.

No reply has been received to this communication, and in the circumstances, the Classing Committee who had the case before them on Tuesday, the 13th instant, decided to expunge the class from the Register Book with a red line (9.21), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Owners have been informed accordingly.
