I beg to remind you that I have not yet been favoured with a reply to my letters of the 6th June and 23rd August, regarding the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steam trawler "VICTORIA", and to state that the case of this vessel came before the Committee at their Meeting today, when it was decided to defer action until Tuesday next, when they regret that unless a reply be received from you with regard to the completion of the Special Survey No.2, which is so long overdue, there will be no alternative but to expunge the vessel's class without further notice.


