In reply to enquiry, the Hartlepool Surveyors now forward letter from the Owners, in which they state, the reason of the delay in completing the survey is that they are contemplating the conversion of the ship from a trawler to a cargo vessel, and if the arrangement is come to, the reconstruction could be carried out under survey, and one operation would do for the whole business.

They add that if and when this matter is fixed up, they will communicate with the local Surveyors.

It is submitted action be deferred for a short time.
