The vessel has been laid up at Ymuiden and the usual undertaking was furnished by the Owners.

The Amsterdam Surveyors now forward a letter from the Owners in which they state they regret that financial circumstances make it necessary for them to discontinue the classification, but they hope to be able when circumstances improve to submit the vessel for reclassification.

The year of grace expired 4,24.

It is submitted that in the circumstances the vessel's class be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
