With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your Steam Trawler "ZAANSTROOM IV", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had the case of this vessel under consideration to-day, and that in view of the vessel being laid up at Ymuiden the Committee are agreeable to the 2nd Special Survey No.1 being postponed for the present in the event of it not being convenient to you to complete the same at an early date, on the condition they usually require in the cases of vessels which are overdue for survey and are lying up indefinitely, viz:- that the survey be carried out before the vessel is again sent to sea, and that you undertake to have this done if she remain your property, and, should she be offered for sale, to inform intending purchasers that the class is allowed to remain subject to this being done.

I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly sign and return to me the enclosed form of letter on the subject.
