With reference to the case of the ex-German Steamer "MARIE REPPEL" which has been under the survey of the Society's Surveyors at Hull for condition on being taken over by the British Government, and to the intimation made by Mr Latta over the telephone on the 17th August last that if the necessary work for classification of the vessel could be done at the time he would be glad if this could be arranged, I have now the pleasure to inform you that reports on the vessel have been received from the Society's Surveyors at Hull, and the Committee, who have had the matter before them, have been able to assign to the vessel the "100 A-" Class with record of "LMC 10.20", subject to the safety valves being adjusted and the machinery tried under steam in the presence of a Surveyor to this Society.

I enclose herewith an account for the fee due for the survey for condition and classification, and on receipt of your remittance in settlement I shall have pleasure in forwarding you the classification certificates.
