Survey

When due

The s.s.No.3 became due 7.23 and the Boiler Survey 9.23.

The Cardiff Surveyors stated in March last they were informed by the Owners that the vessel was expected to return from the fishing grounds within the following fortnight and that she was under offer for sale to a French Firm, who were then to make an examination, but in the event of the proposed sale not taking place the present Owners undertook to have the above surveys carried out at the vessel's next return after Easter.


The case received consideration on the 1st ultimo when attention was deferred for the present.

The same Surveyors now forward a letter from the Owners in which they state they have decided to allow the class of the vessel to lapse. This decision being mainly due to the high cost of carrying out the surveys.

It is submitted the vessel's class be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
