In a previous similar case viz:- that of the "Colomba" No. 55119 in the Register Book, it was understood that the action taken in regard to the classification of the vessel was done without the knowledge of Commander Fera, the Director General of the Lloyd Mediterraneo.

It will, of course, be necessary for the two lengths of cable to be compared with the certificates, when, if it is found that the Society's Requirements in regard to testing have been complied with, the case could be considered even although the testing of the cables was not done under the supervision of the Society's Surveyors.
