Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 21st ultimo in further reference to the Car-ferry Steamers mentioned in my letter of the 30th May.

Your remarks have been carefully noted and in the circumstances the Committee have given instructions for the Classes and all other particulars of the steamers "DARICA", "LAPSEKI" and "TUZLA" to be omitted from the next reprint of the Society's Register Book.

With regard to the remaining vessels, viz "CARDAK", "DERINCE", "MUDANYA" and "SILIVRI", it is noted that these are in commercial service, and as the screwshaft Survey of the "MUDANYA" became due at the end of December last it will be appreciated if you will kindly ascertain and let me know what arrangements are proposed to be made for this inspection to take place.

The screwshaft Surveys of the "CARDAK" and "SILIVRI" will become due at the end of the present month and September respectively, and perhaps you will also let me know in due course what arrangements are proposed for the carrying out of these inspections.

The screwshaft Survey of the "DERINCE" becomes due at the end of December next.
