Nature of Survey _____

This vessel was built with a view to class 10 A- but action was deferred owing to the machinery survey not being completed.

The Seville Surveyor now reports that the oil engines have been removed and some minor repairs effected.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to be classed 10 A- in the Sailing Ship Register Book, and to have the record of survey 1.19 as recommended by the Cadiz Surveyor.
