S/S "PARKLANDS".

We are in receipt of your letter of yesterday's date, and, in reply, as already stated, we will have the bunkers and the testing of the tank in the way thereof, surveyed by you on steamer's return from her present voyage if it is practicable to do so.

You will understand that it is a very difficult matter to gauge the quantity of bunkers that will be remaining in the vessel on her return, and if it is only a small quantity resting, then, of course, the survey can take place.

If it is impossible to hold the survey on vessel's return this voyage, we will do our best to arrange to supply steamer with bunkers so that when she again returns to this country, she will only have a few tons resting, but it is a difficult matter at any time to arrange the quantities.


