
With reference to the enclosed Freeboard Verification for the S. S. "PARKLANDS" (No. 55 in the Supplement.) I beg to state that the Freeboards have ^{been} cut in the vessels sides in accordance with the Freeboard Certificate dated the 6th, January, 1915, which is returned herewith for cancellation that the strake below the sheerstrake is being doubled throughout the fore well on each side. It is expected that work will be completed about the 3rd proximo, and a Report will be forwarded in due course.

The Owners have not found it convenient to deal, at this time, with the other outstanding matters viz., "The examination of the bunkers and the testing of the engine and boiler room in way of the bunkers," but this work will be carried out at the first opportunity.

The First Entry and deferred Reports are returned herewith for reference.
