The HULL Surveyors report this ex-German vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated, a GENERAL EXAMINATION carried out, and minor repairs effected.

The tonnage well aft has been fitted out to accommodate seamen and two wood lifeboats and two liferafts placed on board.
