S. The report of survey recently held on this vessel in drydock at Birkenhead has been under consideration today and, as a result of this inspection, a notation of "Examined L.R. 10,45" valid for twelve months, will be inserted in the Register Book as recommended by the Surveyors. A notation of DBS 10,45 in respect of the Donkey Boiler Survey will also be made.

It is noted that the screwshaft was not drawn for inspection on this occasion presumably in view of the fact that the vessel was only completed in 1943, but it is considered that this shaft should be surveyed at a convenient opportunity and I shall be obliged if you will kindly bear this point in mind.
