The Silver Line, Ltd., survey the M.V. "EMPIRE NIDD" ex "MINDEN", 4742 Gross Tons of London, formerly classed with the Germanischer Lloyd on the 19th July, 1945 and subsequently, and that the following parts of hull and machinery were generally examined in dry dock and afloat, viz:-

HULL:- Shell plating, rudder, holds, tween decks, coal bunker space structure under donkey boiler, fore and aft peaks, machinery spaces, decks, casings, ashshoot, ventilators, hatchways and closing appliances general equipment, steering gear and windlass, anchors and cables.

MACHINERY:- Propeller and outside fastenings of sea connections.

Main Engine. Nos.1,2,4,5,6 & 7 cylinder liners, covers, pistons and valves, No.2 crankpins and bearings, No.2 crankshaft journal and bearings.

Combined main engine jacket cooling water and piston cooling water pumps.

Port and emergency generator engine cylinders, liners, pistons, covers, valves, valve gears, gudgeon pins and bushes, crankshaft and bearings.

After boiler feed water pump.

Port and starboard starting air receivers internally and externally with mountings.

Coal fired vertical donkey boiler internally and externally with mountings, manholes, doors and their fastenings.

Safety valves adjusted under steam at 105 lbs. per sq. in.

La Mont water tube boiler examined with mountings, elements hydraulically tested and safety valves adjusted under steam at 120 lbs per sq. inch. Boiler circulating pump examined.

Steam pipes 3" diameter hydraulically tested.

ELECTRICAL. Electrical equipment consisting of generators, motors, control gear, switchboards, cables and fittings generally examined. Installation tested under working conditions.
