Dear Sirs,

Trawler (AMROTH CASTLE) "BRIDESMAID".

I am in receipt of your letter of the 12th inst., and as intimated to you over the telephone I am informing the Society's Surveyor at Fleetwood of the circumstances of the case and that if practicable you will desire a Special Survey No. 1 to be held or alternatively a General Examination in accordance with the committee's wartime requirements.

With regard to the cases in which you enquire as to the amount of fees which would be charged for reclassification surveys I beg to inform you that in these instances the rule fee for a Special Survey No. 3 would be required as follows:-

|--------------------------|-------------|------------------|
| "JAMAICA" (NOW CLASSED). | £8.         | £4.              |
| "EVERTON" (BROKEN UP).   | £8.         | £4.              |
| "JUNCO"                  | £7.         | £5.              |

According to the records here electric light was not fitted in these vessels when their classes were withdrawn and if an electrical equipment is now fitted the rule fee for electrical survey would be chargeable in addition.

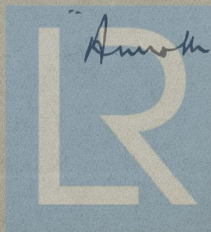
