Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 23rd instant forwarding separate reports of damage and Condition Surveys held on the ex-German Steamer "GOLDENFELS", and have to acquaint you that the Condition Survey reports in this case have now been forwarded to the Ministry of Shipping here, together with an account for fees of £25 for the Hull Survey and £15 for the Machinery.

Of these amounts, £25 for the Hull Survey and £10 for the Machinery will be credited to your port on payment and should be passed through your Books in the usual way.

At the same time I return herewith the damage survey reports forwarded by you on this vessel, and have to request that you will hand the same to the Managers or their representatives at your port on payment of the fees suggested in your letter.
