Dear Sirs,

I enclose herewith a copy of a letter dated the 11th ult received from the Managers of the ex-German steamer "GOLDENFELS", from which you will observe that the vessel is proceeding to Swansea for the discharge of her cargo, and will then be sent to another Bristol Channel port for Condition Survey on being taken over by the British Government.

I have therefore to request that you will give the case the necessary attention in the event of the vessel proceeding to your port for the requisite survey, and for your information and guidance I also enclose a copy of the report of partial survey held at this port on the vessel's machinery.

With regard to the Managers' request for an assignment of freeboard, all the particulars detailed on the back of Form 11b should be furnished.
