I beg to acquaint you that the Committee of this Society have to-day had before them a communication received from the Society's Surveyors at Nantes, from which it appears that all your fleet of trawlers are now classed with the Bureau Veritas.

Your trawlers "ROCHE BLEUE" and "ROCHE VELEN" at present hold the Society's classification, but the "ROCHE BLEUE" is due for screwshaft survey and the "ROCHE VELEN" will become due for this inspection next month, and I have to say that in view of the above intimation, the Committee have now given instructions for the classes of these vessels to be withdrawn from the Register Book, and three dots (...) inserted in lieu in each case, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
