

The screwshaft survey of the first-named Trawler became due in August last, and in reply to inquiry the Society's Nantes Surveyors state they are informed by the Owners that all their fleet are now classed with the Bureau Veritas.

The only other Trawler belonging to this Company holding the Society's classification is the "ROCHE-VELEN" which becomes due for screwshaft survey next month, and in the circumstances, the Classing Committee who had the cases before them on Friday, the 19th instant and Tuesday the 23rd instant respectively, decided to give instructions for the classes of both vessels to be withdrawn from the Register Book, and three dots (...) inserted in lieu in each case, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
