S. Reverting to my letter of the 25th February last respecting the surveys overdue on the boiler and screw shaft of your Steamer "OURA MARU", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have now had before them a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Kobe, from which it appears that they have not received any reply from your goodselves to letters addressed to you by them on this subject, and in the circumstances, the Committee regret that they have had no alternative but to expunge the vessel's class with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have to add that upon the receipt of a satisfactory report from the Society's Surveyors on the completion of the necessary surveys and repairs, the case will receive the favourable consideration of the Committee, with a view to the reinstatement of the class.
