S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the Steam Trawler "NEPTUNE I" ex "ANNIBAL", which vessel it is understood has recently become your property, I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had the case before them together with a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Bordeaux, from which it appears that you do not propose to retain her classification with this Society.

As, however, the Special Annual Survey of the Boilers became due so long ago as April, 1919, and the Special Survey No. 3 also fell due in March last, the Committee regret that they have no alternative but to expunge the vessel's class with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

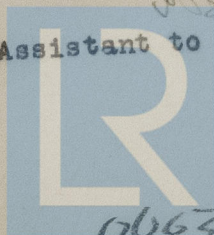
