He informed us that he had bought the "ANNIBAL" to replace his trawler "VENUS II", which was sunk during the war, and that he had then sold the vessel to Mr. Victor Bousquet, La Rochelle.

The latter gentleman now informs us that he has decided to class the vessel with the Bureau Veritas and that he does not propose to retain the classification in Lloyd's Register.

The name of the vessel has been changed to "NEPTUNE I" and the port of Registry is La Rochelle.

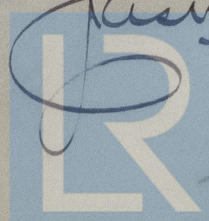
