I have to acquaint you that in April last the Committee agreed to the class of the steam trawler "ANNIBAL" being retained in the Register Book on the understanding that the Boiler Survey, which is now long overdue, would be carried out before the vessel was again employed. I enclose herewith for your information a copy of a letter which has now been received from the Society's Paris Office in regard to the vessel, and shall be glad if you will take the matter up on her arrival at Rochefort and ascertain and let me know what definite arrangements are proposed to be made to have the requisite survey held.
